

"On September 20, 2016 MathWorks notified us that their MATLAB software is not compatible with macOS 10.12." MathWorks recommends not updating at this time.

On October 6th, MathWorks applied a patch to MATLAB and MATLAB Runtime in the downloadable version of R2016b for Mac. No patch is required if you downloaded R2016b after October 6th.

This software is governed by the terms and conditions of an agreement between UNC Charlotte and Mathworks. Faculty/Staff and students are permitted to download and use the programs on their personally owned computers, on campus, off campus, and via remote access. Acceptable use includes performing software administration, teaching, and noncommercial, academic research.

Installation Instructions for MatLab:

## System Requirements

Note: The typical MatLab installation requires 3-4 GB of disk space.

Note: It will take about 1.5 hours to download the software depending on your internet speed

1. Go to <http://www.mathworks.com>
  - a. Click on **Log In** in the upper right corner and select **Create Account**
    - i. Enter your UNC Charlotte Email address (with the @unc.edu domain)
    - ii. Country/Region
    - iii. Select **Academic use (including campus/site license use)**
    - iv. Are you at least 13 years or older: Yes
  - b. Click **Create** button
2. Log into your UNC Charlotte email account and open the verification email from MathWorks and do the following:
  - a. Click on the **Verify your email** button
  - b. In the MathWorks Account window that appears, provide the information requested for the section above the **Associate Your Account to a License**, then click the **Create** button
  - c. The MathWorks Account window will show the message **Your profile was created** message, and you are now logged into the MathWorks website
3. On the MathWorks web page, if you are not already logged in, click the **Log in** link in the upper right hand corner using the account credentials you just created above.
4. Click on your name in the upper right hand corner and select **My Account**
5. In the **My Licenses** section, under the heading **Associate with a License**, click **Associate License**
6. In the new tab or windows that opens, do the following:
  - a. Copy/Paste or type in the following license number:  
83832-17475-45722-37847-37559 into the box
  - b. Click **Associate License** to the right of the code you just entered into the box

7. You will then see a **Success Message** and be provided with a License number
  - a. Write down the License number in case you need it for the future
8. Click **Download Your Products Now** link
9. Click **Download** under the heading **Licensed Products and Updates**
10. Click the **version you want to download**
11. Click on the corresponding operating system that you are currently using

For Apple OS Installations:

1. Go to the Downloads folder and open the MATLAB folder
2. Double-click the file InstallForMacOSX
3. Go through the install process (**note important steps below**)
  - a. Log in with your MathWorks account when prompted
  - b. Select a license key. Select License# 1078459
  - c. Wait while all the applications download
4. After MathWorks has finished downloading all the software, activate MatLab
5. After activation you will find MatLab in your Applications folder

For Windows OS Installations:

1. Go to the Downloads folder and open the downloaded file
2. Click **Run** to start unzipping the file
3. Go through the install process (**note important steps below**)
  - a. Log in with your MathWorks account when prompted
  - b. Select a license key. Select License# 1078459
  - c. Wait while all the applications download
4. After MathWorks has finished downloading all the software, activate MatLab
5. After activation you will find the MatLab shortcut on your Desktop or on your Start menu
